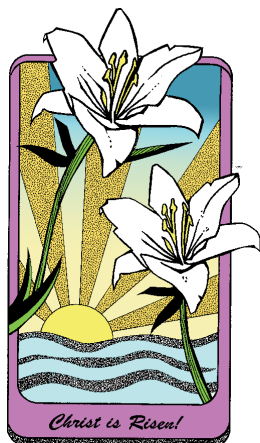

The Giving Tree is for the FLITE CENTER

When young people transition from foster care to independent living, the **FLITE Center** is there to assist them. The **FLITE Center** is a central resource for young people in Broward County's dependency system, offering a single, convenient point of access to a broad range of services and support they need to become successful adults. The **FLITE Center** is a centralized facility for dependent youth to learn the skills needed for independent living. The topics of concentration include the importance of completion of education, budgeting and finance, job and vocational training, housing options, and other essential skills needed to live independently.

Items needed are ordinary household items the young people will need to set up house in an apartment.

New items like can openers, toasters, coffee makers, salt/pepper shakers, cooking utensils, potholders, laundry soap, bath towels, kitchen towels, full size sheets, measuring cups and spoons, pots and pans are all needed.

Instructions: Please take a tag from the tree. Place the tag in the bag with the item(s) you purchased and place it under the tree before the end of the month. We'll do the rest!

WE ARE KNOWN BY OUR FRUIT

This week, Jesus tells us that we must examine our own inner selves, our attitudes and dispositions, virtues and faults, rather than judging others. What is in our hearts comes out in what and how we speak. If our hearts are filled with kindness and compassion, those qualities will be evident in our speaking, just as beautiful, wholesome fruit comes only from healthy trees. And vice-versa. The Wisdom writer Sirach in the first reading agrees with this concept—that we will be judged by our words. Paul reminds us that the reward of discipleship is eternal life. Today's psalm of thanksgiving and praise reminds us of God's kindness and faithfulness, which we are to emulate in our thoughts, words, and deeds. We are known, each of us, by our own fruit.

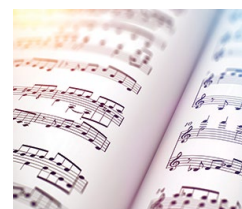

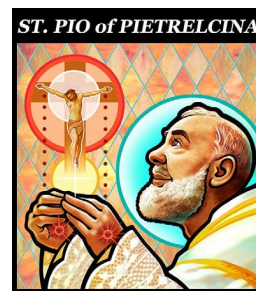
