The **FLITE Center** is a central resource for young people in Broward County's dependency system, offering a single, convenient point of access to a broad range of services and support they need to become successful adults. The **FLITE Center** is a centralized facility for dependent youth to learn the skills needed for independent living. The topics of concentration include the importance of completion of education, budgeting and finance, job and vocational training, housing options, and other essential skills needed to live independently.

Items needed are ordinary household items the young people will need to set up home in an apartment.

New items like can openers, toasters, coffee makers, salt/pepper shakers, cooking utensils, potholders, laundry soap, bath towels, kitchen towels, full size sheets, measuring cups and spoons, pots and pans are all needed.


PRAYER OF THE WEEKSixth Sunday in Ordinary Time
