# And then there was light

Thank you, Mr. And Mrs. Amaturo

COVID-19 made its imprint on history as one of the darkest times in modern society. Lives were lost. Extended families were separated. Businesses closed, some for good. A less reported consequence of this devastating disease was the impact those tumultuous years had on our educational system, especially our children. The academic and social skills of our youth stood still, and in many areas, regressed. Unfortunately, St. Jerome Catholic School in Fort Lauderdale was not spared this consequence.

Last summer, I was hired to lead St. Jerome. At this time, the Accelerated Reader program at the school was defunct. Having experienced the enormous success of the program at my previous school, I knew that reigniting the AR program at St. Jerome was essential to the success of her students' ability to move forward. Thankfully, Terry Maus, a former assistant principal and technology teacher at St. Jerome, had a long-standing relationship with South Florida philanthropists Joseph and Winifred Amaturo, who so graciously donate the program to St. Jerome and countless other schools. Mrs. Maus and I had worked together before, and she knew that I and her team could bring the AR program back to life.

I quickly went to work hiring outstanding teachers who also believed in the tremendous benefits of the program, one being Colleen Ramroth, who brings over 20 years of

teaching experience to St. Jerome. She quickly emerged as a leader in the program and was designated as the Accelerated Reader coordinator of the school. Mrs. Ramroth shared her expertise by training teachers and inspiring students. When not teaching her second-grade class, she made sure to encourage students in all grade levels by giving tips, advice and accolades. With the generosity of Mrs. Maus, St. Jerome held its first AR contest in years. The excitement was building, and the students were reading! By the end of the third quarter of 2021-22 school year, the entire school was fully participating in the AR program. In March, St. Jerome was honored by a personal visit from the Amaturos, who were able to meet the top reading student, participate in classroom raffles and enjoy the benefits of what their foundation does for the lives of all the children they touch. The AR program at St. Jerome has been an integral component in bringing the students out of the darkness of COVID times and into the light of reading success. St. Jerome will forever be thankful for the Amaturos' generosity, Mrs. Maus' confidence in the faculty, and the dedicated teachers who worked tirelessly to rekindle the program. We continue to be amazed by our students who consistently teach us that there is nothing that we cannot accomplish with hard work, perseverance, and the light and grace of our Lord.


