



The FLITE Center is a centralized facility for dependent youth to learn the skills needed for independent living. The topics of concentration include the importance of completion of education, budgeting and finance, job and vocational training, housing options, and other essential skills needed to live independently.

Items needed are ordinary household items the young people will need to set up house in an apartment.

New items like can openers, toasters, coffee makers, salt/pepper shakers, cooking utensils, potholders, laundry soap, bath towels, kitchen towels, full size sheets, measuring cups and spoons, pots and pans are all needed.


