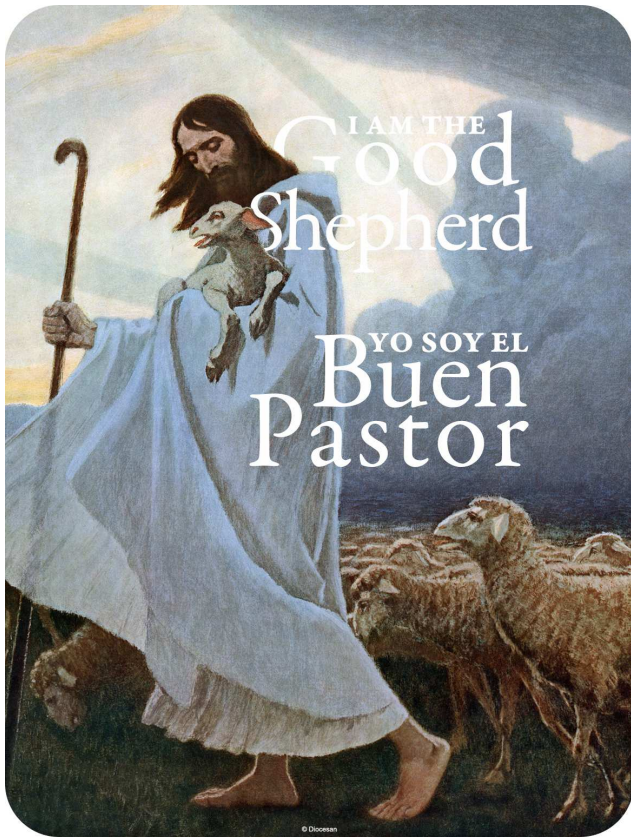

Last weekend our 7th and 8th grade students competed in the Cardinal Gibbons ChiefMUN event. We are so proud of all of our students who participated. We are thrilled to announce that our 7th grade delegate, Kathryne C., won Best Speaker of the ChiefMUN General Assembly Committee Representative of China. Way to go, Katy! Panther Proud! We are so grateful to our social studies and comparative writing teacher, Mrs. Bolduc, for moderating the event. We are blessed!

Our school is currently running the World's Finest Chocolate fundraiser. We will be outside the church this Saturday and next Saturday selling chocolate bars. It was a rewarding and engaging experience for all involved. 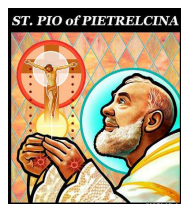
