Greetings, Parishioners. I pray this letter finds you well. Our faculty and students will return on Monday after having off for Easter break. We have missed them on campus and look forward to their return. We have only 40 school days left in the 2023-2024 school year. We look forward to ending the year with a strong Panther finish. We are excited to announce that we will be adding Algebra 1 to our math curriculum for the 2024-2025 school year for those 8th graders who qualify. Our current 7th graders will take a placement test to see if they qualify for the advanced class for next school year. We are proud of our students who view academic excellence as a priority in their school life.

SJCS will also be adding middle school electives for the 2024-2025 school year. We are still in planning in the stages, but currently we have scheduled to offer STREAM, debate, pottery, public speaking, and guardian angel sewing group. We are working to add a few more choices to our elective program. Middle school electives are a wonderful addition to our academic curriculum as they provide an opportunity for the students to choose an area of interest to develop. We are thankful to our SJCS faculty for providing these opportunities for our school students.

Enrollment for new school families continues. Our classes are filling up quickly. Currently we only have 5 more spots open in kindergarten with a few applications pending. 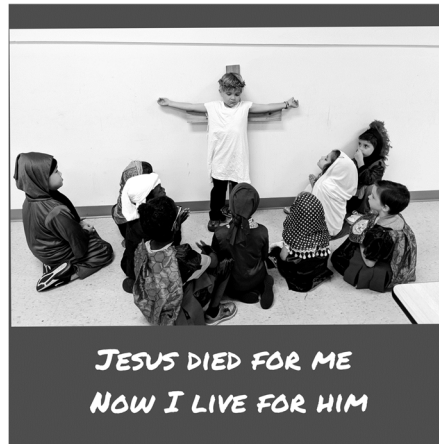

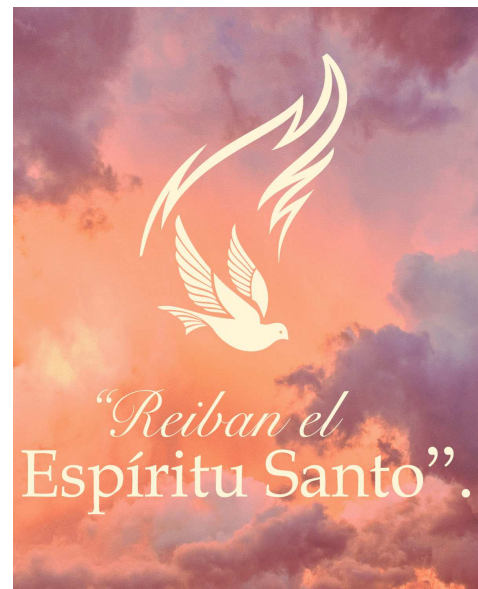

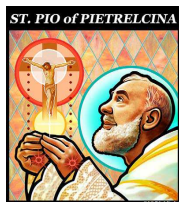
